#### Season Highlights:

#### **CONCERTS**

We had another tremendous 5 concert season starting with:

Oct. 26 and our "Light of Day" concert featuring auditory and visual delights as we played music set to the beautiful images of our area taken by local photographers. With over 500 images submitted it was very difficult to choose but we were able to feature 25 photographers and are very grateful for the work they submitted.

Dec. 14 was our ever popular "Winter Festival" concert as we connected with our love of hockey and all things winter in or presentation of a reading of "The Hockey Sweater narrated by the author himself, Roch Carrier and set to the lovely music of Abigail Richardson-Schulte. Favourite songs of the season rounded out this inspiring night.

Mar. 1 was a highlight of bright, brass sounds as we featured "True North Brass", a world renowned Canadian brass quintet who also shared their expertise in conducting a brass workshop for local musicians.

April 12- Raums & Brahms - was a lovely concert featuring the virtuosity of Erica Raum on the violin as she played Tchaikovsky's Violin Concerto in D Major. The orchestra was pleased to perform Brahms'

For the 10th year, the Grade 4 "Instruments of the Orchestra" and Grade 5 "Rhythms in Use" programs were organized with musicians again visiting over 40 classrooms in North Bay and area. #### STRING RETREAT

A 4<sup>th</sup> annual chamber music string retreat at the Canadian Ecology Centre was led by Music Director Tom Jones and coached by the members of the Silver Birch String Quartet. We had the largest group to date with participants from across Ontario involved in honing their skills; performing as small ensembles and a string orchestra and listening to chamber concerts.

#### COMMUNITY "SIZZLE"
